Reading - Choose a CHAPTER book that's on your level. You are going to read your book and write a summary of your book. Your summary should include all of the important information. Who's the main character? Where and when does the story take place? What's the conflict? How's the conflict resolved? What did you learn from the book? Would you recommend this book to others? You may type or write your report. It should be at least one page. Please also include a cover. Your cover should be a new design for the book. It could be a picture of an important scene or character. It should also include the title of the book and the author's name. Be creative with the design of the new cover. Also, BRING THE BOOK WITH YOU ON THE FIRST DAY OF SCHOOL - We will be creating something when you return to school :)

Writing - I want to know ALL about YOU!!! Write a letter to your 6th grade teacher. You don't know who your homeroom teacher will be yet, so, just address it as "Dear 6th Grade Teacher,". Include any information that you feel would be important for your teacher to know about you. You can tell us about your family, what you like to do outside of school, your interests, your favorite movies, tv shows, music, sports, animals, books, etc. You can tell us about school and what your favorite subjects are or even what you hope to improve in this year. We want to get to know you as a person. Make sure that you include enough information for us to do that. You can type or write your letter on lined paper. You may also decorate your letter. We look forward to meeting you in September!!
